Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Land Transport (Fees and Penalties) Regulations.

Prescribed fees

2.—(1) The fees payable under the Act and regulations made under it are as prescribed in Schedule 1.

(2) The following are exempted from paying the fee prescribed under the Act or any regulations made under it—

- (a) the President and Vice-President of the State;
- (b) the government of another country or an institution, an international organisation or a person to which or to whom section 6, section 12(1) or section 12 (2) of the Diplomatic Privileges and Immunities Act applies;
- (c) the Government of the Fiji Islands; **(LN 43/03)**
- (d) any fire brigade established under the provisions of any Act in respect of motor vehicles operated by such fire brigade; and **(LN 43/03)**
- (e) any authority, institution or person exempted under any other written law **(LN 43/03)**

(3) An authority, institution or person exempted from payment of fees under sub-regulation (2) must advise the Authority within 7 days of any change in circumstances as a result of which sub-regulation (2) no longer applies.

Prescribed penalties and fixed penalties

3.—(1) A penalty prescribed in column 4 and column 5 of Schedule 2 is the fixed penalty payable on the issue of a Traffic Infringement Notice in respect of an offence against

the section of the Act or regulation respectively prescribed in column 3 of Schedule 2.

(2) The penalty prescribed in column 6 and 7 of Schedule 2 is the maximum penalty for an offence against the Regulation respectively prescribed in column 3.

(3) Where the prescribed penalty is shown \$ /..... months or similar in column 7 of Schedule 2, the court may impose a fine up to the maximum shown or a term of imprisonment up to the maximum period shown or both such fine and such imprisonment.

- (4) The 'TIN Code' mentioned in column 2 of Schedule 2 is to be used—
- (a) by the Authority, police and courts in administering Traffic Infringement Notices; and
 - (b) in the records of the Authority in relation to the issue of such notices.

Revocation of Order

4. The Motor Vehicle Licence Fees (Exemption) Order is revoked.
