
Process for Traffic Infringement Notices (TIN'S) Payments



- Do not contact LTA for disputed TIN's work through the resolution method of the Fiji Courts.
- LTA Officials have no powers to waive, recind, cancel, vary or expunge TIN's. If you contact LTA in any way requesting this you will be referred to FICAC.
- A traffic Infringement Notice must be issued and despatched by the Authority within 21 days from the date of the offence is committed and any Traffic Infringement Notice issued beyond this period is deemed invalid.
- If a person to whom a Traffic Infringement Notice is issued does not undertake any of the actions above within 12 months from the date of the TIN being issued ,the Traffic Infringement Notice takes effect as a conviction and the Authority may:
 - a) Suspend the person's licence; and
 - b) Seek from the court a sentence providing for the issuance of demerit points and maximum penalties for the offence.
