

## Application for Dangerous Good Course/Permit

The applicant must provide the following documents;

No.	Requirement	Comments
1	Applicant Profile	Curriculum vitae (CV), must outline years of experience.
2	Proof of ID	Birth Certificate or Passport or Statutory Declaration — must be original or certified true copy.
3	Driving License Card	Must possess full driving license for class 2 or 6 or 7 — if copy then must be certified true copy
4	Photograph	Must be within a year, must be 2 photos - must be certified true copy
5	Police Vetting	Recent Police Clearance
6	Defensive Driving Course Certificate	Must be valid, if copy then must be certified true copy
7	Medical Certificate	Must be within a year, if copy then must be certified true copy
8	Letter from Company	Letter from employer (company) stating the applicant is employed with them and what all duties he/she is tasked to perform
9	Traffic Infringement Notices	All fines with LTA must be cleared prior to payment of Dangerous Goods Fees
10	Application Form	To be filled by applicant and advice will be given by LTA Training Coordinator or LTA Standards & Engineering Officer for payment of application fees after vetting all the submitted documents

For 1 year validity — Driver Permit — Issue annual Hazardous Subs. Driver permit	\$6.84
For 3 year validity - Driver Permit — Issue annual Hazardous Subs. Driver permit 3 years	\$21.52
