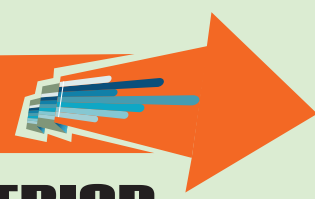

POPULATION & VEHICLE REGISTRATION RATIOS OVER 10 YEAR PERIOD

Fiji 2007 Census Population = 831,271

For 2016, the data implies that in every 100,000 people there were 7 fatalities and 5 fatalities for every 10,000 vehicles. Additionally, it was noted that for every 1,000 people there were 132 vehicles as compared to 2015 which increased by 9%. A point to consider that as the total vehicles registered in 2016 increased by 9%, the fatality rate declined by 8%.

Note: The above ratios are calculated based on the official population data by Fiji Bureau of Statistics (Census) and vehicle registration data obtained internally at LTA. The official statistics on road fatalities was provided by the Fiji Police Force - National Traffic Command Center.
