Modifications to Your Vehicle – The Process Explained.

Should you wish to modify your vehicle from its original manufacturers build specification you must do the following and obtain **prior written approval** from the Authority using the prescribed application form. Do not buy or fit any equipment without the approval first being given in writing.

Examples of modifications requiring prior written approval (infographic):

MAKING THE FACTS Modifications to your vehicle

If you intend modifying your vehicle from the manufacturer's original specification you must obtain written prior approval from the LTA by applying on the correct application form.

Illegal Bull Bar obscuring number plate **Illegal Front Light** **Illegal rotating number plate** **Illegal Tint and rotating number plate**

As per the specimen charge, the following is the TIN for any type of modification done to a motor vehicle;

14. Modification of Motor Vehicle by the owner without prior Approval of Land Transport Authority;

a. Individual – Fixed Penalty of \$75-00. Maximum Penalty of \$1000/ 6 months imprisonment
b. Company – Fixed Penalty of \$300-00. Maximum penalty of \$1000/ 6 months imprisonment.

Some modifications may be approved upon application to LTA before the proposed modification is carried out. This is called an **Exemption Permit**. If you have one and sell the vehicle the Permit is not Transferable.
