

EXPIRED PSV PERMIT COMPLIANCE

The Land Transport Authority (LTA) wishes to inform all Public Service Vehicle (PSV) Permit holders/operators that all expired PSV permits that were received by the Authority from 10 July 2000 to 30 September 2017 was processed for the renewal in line with the Land Transport [Public Service Vehicles] Regulation 2017.

Pursuant to Sub-Regulation 3, For the purpose of sub regulation [2], a permit may only be renewed if;

- a) *A new application for renewal is lodged by the permit holder on or before **30 September 2017**;*
- b) *The permit holder is a resident*
- c) *The Authority is satisfied that the permit holder is not in breach of the Act, any subsidiary laws made under the Act or any condition attached to the permit and*
- d) *The Authority is satisfied from its own records or, where the Authority has no records relating to the permit holder's former application for renewal as the permit holder may produce, that the permit holder was a permit holder and had applied for the renewal of the permit.*

4. If a permit holder qualifies for the renewal of a permit under sub regulation [2] and [3] but does not lodge a new application for renewal of the permit on or **before 30 September 2017**, such permit held maybe cancelled and such cancellation is effective from 10 October 2017 pursuant to Regulation 12 (1) of the Land Transport (Public Service Vehicles) Regulation 2000, *"the Authority may cancel ,vary or suspend a permit if a condition subject to which the permit was granted has not been complied with and the authority is satisfied that the breach is serious ,frequent or causes inconvenience or danger to the public"*.

LTA advises all expired permit holders to surrender their expired permits to LTA. Failure to surrender expired permits/operating with expired permits will result in necessary action being taken against individual (s).
