

## EXTENSION OF PSV MOTOR VEHICLE UTILIZATION PERIOD

The Land Authority (LTA) wishes to advise all Public Service Vehicles (PSV) Permit Holders that from 01 November 2021, LTA will be issuing an extension of additional twelve (12) months to the existing three (3) months PSV Motor Vehicle Revocation Period to allow valid PSV Permits Holders to register a suitable motor vehicle back to the PSV Permit.

The following categories of PSV Permit Holders will be affected by the above extension:

- For motor vehicles revoked from its PSV Permits between 13 September 2019 to 01 November 2021, an additional (12) twelve months will be issued effective from 01 November 2021 for registration of a suitable vehicle to the PSV Permit.
- For current valid Motor Vehicle Revocations, an additional twelve (12) months extension will be given from the expiry of the current valid three (3) month's Motor Vehicle Revocation Period based on this Policy announcement effective from 01 November 2021.
- All future Motor Vehicle Revocation requests will be issued an additional twelve (12) months to the existing three (3) months Motor Vehicle Revocation Period effective from 01 November 2021.

If PSV Permit Holder(s) fail to meet the additional twelve (12) months Motor Vehicle Revocation timeline, the Permit shall be declared void as per Regulation 10(5)(a) of the Land Transport (Public Service Vehicles) Regulations 2000.

If the expiry of the additional twelve (12) month's Motor Vehicle Revocation timeline falls on a non-business day, the Motor Vehicle Revocation timeline shall expire on the next business day.

This Policy announcement is subject to future review and amendments as required.
